

Congregational Guidelines for 100 Missions in 10 Years

Theme

The Scripture focus for 100 Missions in 10 Years is Ephesians 3:20: "Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us. . ."

Start 100 missions in 10 years. It's an aggressive plan. To some, it might seem unachievable. Can our synod do this? Do we have the manpower, money, and ministry resources?

Our Bible verse reminds us who's really in control. It's less about reaching our goal, and more about following Christ's command to "Go and make disciples." We have a message that gives us peace, joy, comfort, and hope no matter what's going on in this world. So let's support this. Let's do our part to get after it, trusting that God is able to do immeasurably more than we could ever ask or imagine.

Materials

Materials to promote 100 Missions in 10 Years were mailed to every congregation in August 2022. Churches that collect and submit offerings on behalf of one or more partner congregations received both their own materials as well as the materials for their partner congregations. Brochure count was based on average weekly attendance from the 2021 WELS Statistical Report. Churches were also mailed instructions, a 100 Missions in 10 Years promotional poster, Home and World Missions maps, and five other general Missions posters. Pray

We humbly and boldly ask for your rich blessing upon this initiative. Bless the recruitment and training of our future missionaries and bless our missionaries and the fields where they serve. Through your people provide us with ample financial resources. Thwart the efforts of those that hinder our work. Grant wisdom, strength, perseverance, and joy to our synod's leaders, our pastors, and our congregations as we face challenges in our work.

In all we do, move all of us to see and do our part in spreading the gospel so that more may know your saving peace. May all we do and accomplish be to the glory of your Name, Amen.

Get Involved

<u>Talk to your district mission board/mission counselor:</u> If you see nearby mission opportunities to daughter a church, start a second site, or enhance a ministry at your congregation, talk with your district mission board to see what your congregation might do to get involved in this synod church planting effort. <u>Host a 100 Missions in 10 Years mission festival:</u> Invite a district mission board member or request a Home Missions speaker to present at a mission festival at your church using our request form at **wels.net/speaker-request**. Promote it using the materials in this mailing and those found online at **wels.net/100in10**.

<u>Promote this initiative at your church</u>: Show the "100 Missions in 10 Years: Lauren's Story" and September *WELS Connection* before, during, or after a church service that month. A new video will be released every month during the fall to show to your congregation and share on your church's social media accounts and in e-mail newsletters. Utilize the social media graphics, bulletin inserts, posters, bulletin board kits, etc., to emphasize Christ's calling for us to "Go and preach the gospel."

<u>Get your school involved</u>: Consider designating "100 Missions in 10 Years" for an upcoming quarter's mission offerings.
